

## Electric Pallet Jack

Used Pallet Jacks Nebraska - Industrial pallet jacks simplify tasks and allow workers to transport wood pallets of various weights within warehouse settings. The unit is steered with a lever which also acts as a pump handle to raise the jack. A small handle located on the tiller allows the forks to be lowered to the ground. This handle releases hydraulic fluid when it is activated. The forks are situated on levers and there are front wheels found on the inside end of the forks. These levers attach to linkages connecting levers which are united with the jack cylinder. The hydraulic jack raises at the end with this system as the links force the wheels down. The forks vertically raise above the jacks' front wheels to lift the load up past the floor and for safety reasons, loads are only raised to clear the floor. Typically, pallet jacks have steering wheels located in the front and each fork often comes with a single or double wheel configuration. Certain models come with a platform to enable the operator to stand as pallets are being transported.

The least expensive metal option is the carbon steel metal pallets which offer superior durability. Stronger than wood or plastic, aluminum pallets are lightweight compared to other materials. As such, they easily resist corrosion, brittle plastic dilemmas and rotting issues, making them popular for military transport, outdoor storage or long-term at-sea outdoor storage.
